*Items NOT accepted: driver's license, checkbooks, rent receipt and insurance papers

_____ If the student does not reside with the birth mother or father an Affidavit of Residence, Custody and Responsibility must be completed, signed and notarized. **Proof of Custody** must accompany this.

_____ Legal Custody- The parent with whom the child lives and has custody must live in our district. Documentation must be presented to support this. The residence of a person who has **legal custody** of a student is deemed to be the residence of the student.

_____ If the legal guardian does not own or lease the residence within the district (i.e. a single parent and student living with grandparents), a n Affidavit of Residence needs to be completed, signed and notarized.
